



Dear Parents and Carers

Thank you for all your support you have given the school during the last six months. We are so excited about opening for all children from Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> September.

We understand that many parents and carers may feel anxious about their child returning to school. Following the latest guidance from the Department for Education, we have worked hard to arrange for the safety and welfare of all our pupils and staff.

Please read the details below which are currently in place for the new school year.

### Classes:

**As outlined in your child's school report, everyone will return to their new class.**

### Attendance

School attendance is mandatory again from the beginning of September. It will be your duty to ensure that your child attends school regularly. We have a responsibility to record attendance and follow up any absence.

### Morning drop off:

Parents will be allowed on school site only to accompany children to their classrooms.

Classroom doors will open at 8.30am for families with ONLY ONE CHILD at Moat. These children will be allowed straight into class and the parent/carer accompanying them will leave the school site immediately.

Classroom doors will remain open for families with MORE THAN ONE CHILD at Moat to arrive from 8.45am. These children will go straight into class and the accompanying parent/carer will leave the school site immediately after all siblings have been dropped at their classes.

**NO ADULTS WILL BE ALLOWED TO REMAIN ON THE PLAYGROUND TO TALK. IF YOU WISH TO DISCUSS ANYTHING WITH ANOTHER PARENT IT MUST TAKE PLACE OFF THE SCHOOL SITE. TEACHERS ON DUTY WILL ASK YOU TO DEPART FROM THE SITE FOR HEALTH AND SAFETY REASONS.**

### Afternoon collection:

Parents will only be allowed on school site to collect their children from classrooms.

Classroom doors will open at 3.00pm for families with ONLY ONE CHILD at Moat. These children will be allowed straight out of class to their parent/carer. They must leave the school site immediately.

Classroom doors will remain open for families with MORE THAN ONE CHILD at Moat to leave from 3.15pm. These children will leave as soon as their parent/carer arrives and will accompany their parents to collect their siblings. When all family members have been collected they must leave the site immediately.

**Please do not arrive before your allocated time**

**If the class teacher needs to talk to you about your child they will phone you – please ensure we have your up to date mobile numbers.**

NO ADULTS WILL BE ALLOWED TO REMAIN ON THE PLAYGROUND TO TALK. IF YOU WISH TO DISCUSS ANYTHING WITH ANOTHER PARENT IT MUST TAKE PLACE OFF THE SCHOOL SITE. TEACHERS ON DUTY WILL ASK YOU TO DEPART FROM THE SITE FOR HEALTH AND SAFETY REASONS.

We kindly request that parents/carers using the site maintain 2m social distancing from anyone not in their household at all times. Please remember that only one adult from each household is permitted to bring their children to school each day. Where possible, parents should walk their children to school and only use public transport if absolutely necessary.

Where possible Y6 should come to school by themselves.

### Food and Drink:

Hot Universal Infant Free School Meals and Free School Meals for children eligible will be available. Therefore, if your child previously had a free school meal at lunch time they can continue to do so. If you previously paid for a hot meal you can also continue to do so. Should you not wish to choose a hot meal in school, your child can bring in a packed lunch from home.

Each group will have its own allocated timeslot for eating which will sit alongside their allocated timeslot for outside play time.

Fruit and vegetables are being provided for KS1 but KS2 need to bring a healthy snack with them to eat during their morning break time. Freedom Friday will continue as normal.

### Cleaning, Hygiene and Symptomatic Individuals:

We will continue to follow all Government guidelines for cleaning, hygiene and Symptomatic Individuals. Please see the Moat risk assessment on the school website for more detail.

### School uniform

All children will be expected to be back in Moat school uniform.

### Breakfast/After school Club

Breakfast club will be open from 8.00am. It is £2.20 per day.

This is free for all children eligible for Free School Meals.

After school club will be running at Robinswood Primary School. Please ask at the office for details.
